HIGH FIVE: The Dallas Morning News nominates UNT history professor for 2021 Texan of the Year

Andrew Torget, Associate Professor in UNT's Department of History, has been nominated as a finalist for *The Dallas Morning News*' 2021 Texan of the Year award. The newspaper's editorial board wrote that it was fascinated by a new field of research gaining attention in Texas that studies thousands of enslaved people who escaped toward freedom through Texas in the 1800s. Dr. Torget has focused his research on the cotton industry and how its growth in the 1820s changed not only the Texas economy but the state's relationship with slavery. Dr. Torget is one of three Texas scholars nominated as finalists. Wrote the DMN's editorial board: "That sounds like a worthy mission to us. And the Texans who are serving it deserve to be finalists for *The Dallas Morning News*' 2021 Texan of the Year." We agree.
